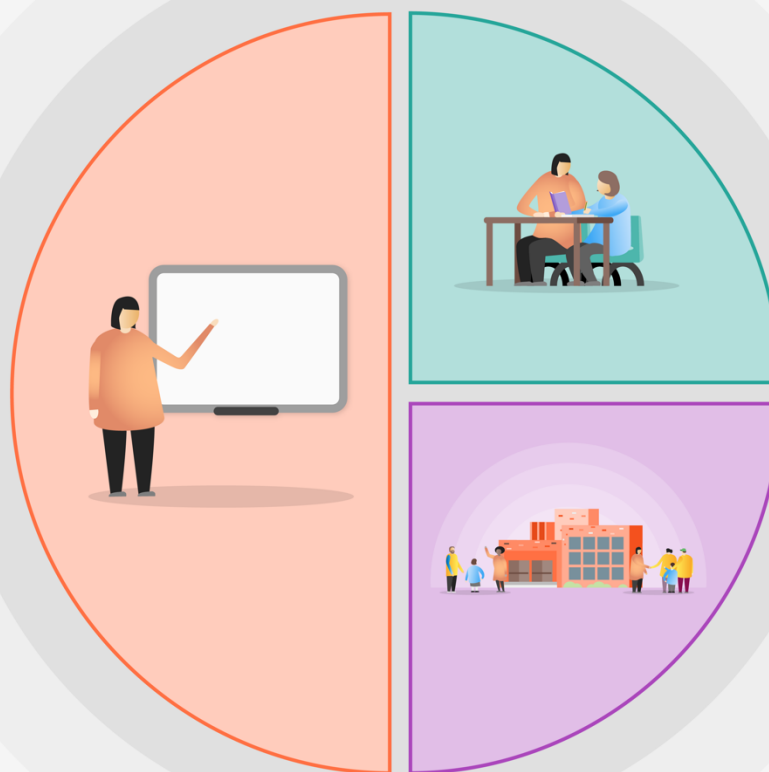


# BIDBURY INFANT SCHOOL COVID CATCH UP PREMIUM OVERVIEW 2020-2021

## 1 Teaching

- Quality First Teaching – provision of high quality teaching – informed CPD for teachers
- Review of vision, values and curriculum pedagogy including teaching and learning principles, vision and values
- Behaviour for learning – Growth Mindset training for all staff
- **Baseline diagnostics and frequent assessments** analysed to show gaps in learning and to inform future planning. Monitoring to ensure all pupils, in particular disadvantaged children and those with SEND experience success and celebrate the acquisition of knowledge
- Introduction of whole class reading alongside Guided reading
- **Recovery curriculum** planned for PSHE, English and Maths – curriculum essentials identified in each year group for all subjects
- **Remote learning**

## 2 Targeted academic support

- Effective deployment of support staff to deliver a range of intervention strategies to accelerate progress
- conferencing/targeted group work and focused feedback
- Lego Therapy to develop communication and social skills
- LSA employment in Y2 for one year to accelerate progress and provide extra support, allowing 15 hrs extra of BRP in Y2
- CM Sports employed to take groups of children for PE while teachers lead targeted small group
- BRP – Extra 15 hours in Y1 **Total: £26,000**

## 3 Wider strategies

- Effective use of HSLW to closely monitor attendance and use strategies to bridge the gap with parents to help raise attendance
- Supporting pupils' social, emotional and behavioural needs
- Oxford Owl subscription for children to access from home (£600)
- Mental Health and Wellbeing whole class books ordered –
- Additional ELSA training
