#### Arriving at School on Time

A number of pupils are arriving late for school in the morning. In one day last week there were 14 children late resulting in 1hr 52 minutes of lost learning. In one week, this could be up to 9 hours and 33 minutes!

Please note that pupils should be on site for **8.55 a.m.** ready to start lessons at 9 a.m. It is extremely disruptive for the rest of the class when a child arrives late. The Home School Link Worker audits our attendance statistics on a monthly basis - including late marks. When a pattern of lateness emerges, the school is directed to contact the parents, in order to rectify the situation and could lead to issuing penalty notices if the lateness continues over time.
