Requesting Days out of School

We can only authorise absence for exceptional circumstances.

We are receiving an increasing number of requests for absence for family holidays and these are the majority of these are not authorised. Therefore, if such absence is 5 days or more in 100 days, we have to issue a penalty notice to parents. The fine is ± 60 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days.

Please note, schools do not receive the fines parents pay, the money goes directly to Hampshire County Council.

As the days are getting hotter this term, please provide sun cream, water bottles and sun hats (all named please!). We are not able to put sun cream on your children in school so would recommend putting cream on them in the morning before school and then we can give children their cream for them to put on themselves if needed later in the day.


Thank you for litter picking in our community, Daisy!

Sports Day



For any parents/familles who cannot attend please do not worry your child will remain with their school adults until normal pick up time

This year we are continuing the tradition we began last year and all the children will be put into houses to encourage team work as well as individual successes. The focus of the houses this year is GB Olympic/Paralympic athletes who may be medal contenders in the 2024 games in Paris.

The children will be competing for their house on Sports Day and the house with the most tokens will win. We feel that a healthy competitive element to Sports Day is important as it builds resilience and competing for their house is a way that the children can support each other and work together. We hope to announce the winning house before you leave on the day.



Teacher Union Strikes

England's largest teaching union has announced two more days of national strike action this term after the education secretary declined to restart negotiations.

Teacher members of the NEU will strike on Wednesday 5 July and Friday 7 July, after the NEU executive voted for further action.

We are again unsure how this will affect us at Bidbury Infant School but we will keep you updated as soon as we know more.

We would recommend that parents prepare for alternative childcare should the strikes lead to the school being closed or partially closed on these days.

Further information on the reasons for teacher strikes is in the school office, supplied by representatives of the NEU. It is important not to rely on the media for a true picture of what truly motivates teachers to make this difficult decision.

Transition to New Classes

Over the last few weeks of term, children will meet their new teacher for next year! The current date for transition is Wednesday 5th July, however due to the potential strikes this date is likely to be moved.

More information will follow as soon as we know more, as this affects all schools in our district.

Teachers are in the process of creating new class lists for children new to years 1 and 2 and, once the children have spent the morning with their new teachers and classes on the transition day, they will come home with a note to share with you which will reveal the new class teacher's name!
