"Hello, I'm Mrs. Buck and I'm a teaching assistant in Year R. I have worked at Bidbury for just over a year now.


I am a mum of three and enjoy going on walks with

Celebrating Learning

<u>Year R</u>



We had Jack the Dinosaur visit Year R after our Science talk during Science Week. He came with his friend, a Paleontologist from Havant & South Downs College. He explained all about fossils, dinosaurs and predators to us.



We have been exploring ice and how it melts over time and whether we can do anything to speed up its melting.

<u>Year 1</u>



We have been learning about Counter Balance in PE, showing great partnership and cooperation!

In English we retold the story of Little Red through role play. The children were so good at role play. They are all able to use story language in their acting!



<u>Year 2</u>

During Science Week, the children looked at dissolving. They started by looking at what happens when we put salt in a glass of water.

They then had a plate of M &Ms. They gently added water and watched to see what happened as the sugar coating started to dissolve.



In Maths, the children have moved on from multiplication to looking at division. They worked together or independently to show their understanding of sharing; dividing a number into 2, 5 or 10 groups.

They used these numbers as they started to make the link between multiplication and division and they know their... 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

Some of the chidren took the challenge to draw the division number sentence and show it with the bar method!
